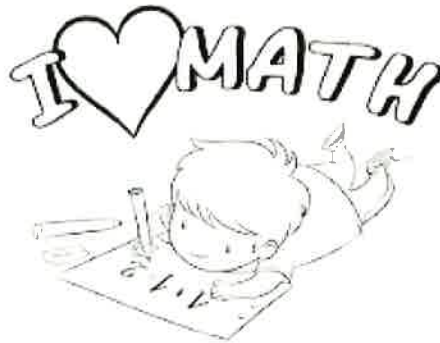

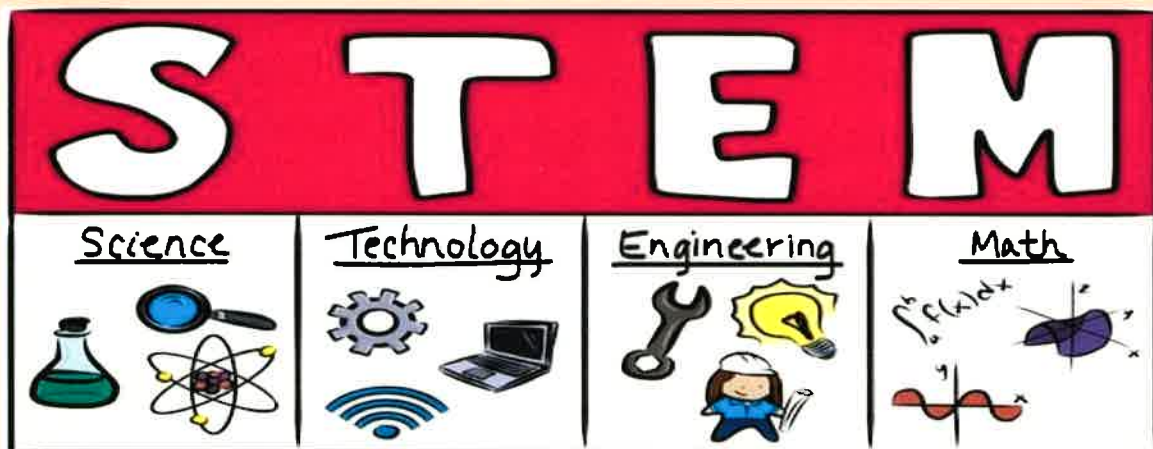

French Fairy Tales

Workshop, Songs and Theatre (June 11 – June 15; June 18- June 22; June 25 – June 29)

WORKSHOP A (June 11 to June 15; 9-3pm) Theatrical Production with Castle (\$315)

Le Chat Botté (Puss-n-Boots)



His Majesty Bestowed on Puss in Boots the Title of Prime Minister
Illustration for *Puss in Boots* by Charles Perrault
Little, Dial Books for Young Readers

For this short stage production of *Puss-n-Boots*, students will learn and memorize simple French words and sentences related to Charles Perrault's famous fairy tale. They will also learn well-loved French cat songs (eg. Francis Poulenc's "La Courte Paille" and « C'est la Mère Michelle Qui A Perdu Son Chat»). Creative activities include designing the stage décor and 17th-century (-ish) costumes for the play. On the last day of camp, students will sing and speak in French in a creative performance of the fairy tale. Parents, guests, and friends will be invited to attend. Each morning will begin with a dual reading of excerpts (in French and English of *Puss n Boots*) with musical accompaniment.

WORKSHOP B (June 18 to June 22; 9-3pm) Shadow Puppet Theatre (\$315)

Le Petit Chaperon Rouge (Little Red Riding Hood)



Students will build a miniature shadow box theatre (complete with curtains and a stage), create paper silhouettes of the main characters in the story of *Little Red Riding Hood*, and learn simple French words and sentences related to the story. They will also learn French songs such as "Promenons-nous dans le bois." On the last day of camp, they will use the stage and shadow puppets to re-enact the fairytale in French. Each session will begin with a dual reading (in French and English of *Little Red Riding Hood*).

WORKSHOP C (June 25 to June 29; 9-3pm) Theatrical Production (\$315)

Les Contes de ma mère l'Oye (Mother Goose Tales – A Medley)



This is a stage production of a medley of popular Mother Goose Tales. Children will design costumes, stage sets, and learn French vocabulary and songs. Parents, guests, and friends will be invited to attend the performance at the end of the camp session.

All workshops are open to elementary-aged children (grades 1-5). Fee for each weekly camp is \$315. Sessions run from 9-3 PM. Children must bring their own lunch and beverages. Snacks will be provided.
